The company is vehemently opposed to all forms of exploitation of human beings, fully supports the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and is committed to ensuring that Human Trafficking, slavery, servitude, and forced or compulsory labour form no part of its supply chain.


BAPP is developing processes and resources to:

- Identify potential risks in the supply chain.
- Train all staff to understand and identify signs of modern slavery of human trafficking.
- Actively monitor each supplier and identify areas of risk.
- Physically audit all major suppliers on at least 1 occasion each year.
- Include questions relevant to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 in our Supplier questionnaire
- Act swiftly and decisively when a possible breach takes place.
- Also apply the same principles to all forms of exploitation of children and child labour within the BAPP Group of Companies organisations and supply chain.

BAPP will provide training to enable all employees to identify situations where modern slavery or human trafficking may be occurring and an environment where employees are encouraged to disclose potential breaches of the act without risk to their own position.

This policy will be reviewed at regular planned intervals to ensure ongoing suitability.
